

- Created in 1972 for global Internet coordination
- Operating unit of ICANN
- Performed under U.S. Government oversight
- Apolitical, technical role
  - Internet works on agreed standards. Others agree them, we record them.



# Root zone management

- Function of most relevance to ccTLDs
- Maintain data for the DNS root
  - Technical data (NS records, "glue")
  - Social data (admin and tech contacts, support organisations, WHOIS, Registration URL)
- Routine changes
  - Confirm authenticity, check for technical problems
- Reassignments
  - Perform evaluation, submit to ICANN board, implement as appropriate.

# Improving Root Zone Management

- Make processes more efficient
  - Software automation
  - Better documentation on processes and procedures
  - Encouraging policy reviews for grey areas
  - Better statistical analysis, to identify problems
  - Working with our 3rd parties to streamline
- ▶ 24×7 Emergency Support
  - In implementation this week, running ASAP!
- Improved Case Management
  - Unified system with all historic records
- Improved authentication

### Other work

- Root Zone Management highest profile, but small percentage of IANA work.
- New systems development in all three sectors
- Improving web page to tie it all together
- Recruiting more staff to cope with load
  - Protocol savvy people wanted (and other roles)
- Building outreach







### The Internet Assigned Numbers Authority

The Internet Assigned Numbers Authority (IANA) is responsible for the global coordination of the DNS Root, IP Addressing, and other Internet Protocol Resources. Our site is organized into three primary navigational tracks:

#### **Domain Names**

IANA manages the DNS Root Zone (assignments of ccTLDs and gTLDs), as well as the .int registry, and the .arpa zone.


