New IPv4 Registry Formats

- No more "Various Registries"
- Clearer field values Unallocated != Reserved
- All registries to be published in XML this summer
- Sample IPv4 preview

ASN Consumption

- ▶ 16 16-bit (2-byte) blocks left
- 2 blocks allocated so far this year
- ▶ 3 blocks allocated in 2006 and 2007
- Distinction between 16 and 32-bit numbers ends on 1 January 2010
