- All unallocated unicast space will be allocated
- Some networks and services already use this space

What does this technique attempt to measure?


PTR queries received at root DNS servers where the IPv4 address is not part of an allocated /8



What does it not measure?

- Usage by otherwise well run sites using unallocated space
 - Split-horizon DNS
 - Egress filters






What are the results?


Let's look at the distribution for all /8s






Let's take a closer look...








Let's remove the allocated /8s and look at the mean QPS last Thursday 10 January
